

TIM FAWLEY



Tim Fawley is the most prolific goal scorer in Frederick County high school history. The 1974 Middletown graduate set game and season goalscoring records that stand today, some 45 years later. Fawley netted a record eight goals in a 1973 Middletown victory over Linganore, and ended that season with a record 40 goals for the season as the Knights went 15-1 and won the very first Maryland Class C state title. He scored at least one goal in every Middletown playoff game in 1972 and 1973. Fawley was a four-year varsity soccer player and two-time Frederick News-Post All-Area selection. Despite back surgery in 1974, Fawley returned to play college soccer at FCC. Coupled with his basketball and baseball accomplishments, he was inducted into the

YMCA Alvin Quinn Hall of Fame in 2011.

Kevin McMullen's boys soccer coaching career greatly impacted two Maryland Counties — Anne Arundel and Frederick. Between 1978 and 1991, he guided programs at Brooklyn Park, his alma mater, and Broadneck to six county titles and four regional championships. He arrived at Thomas Johnson in 1992, and turned a 2-10 program into a conference champion the very first season. In his three seasons at TJ, the program twice reached the regional semifinals. He opened Urbana High School in 1995, where he served as boys soccer head coach and athletic director. His teams were county finalists in 1998, 1999, 2000, 2A West region champs in 2000, region finalists in 2001 and 2002 and county champions in 2002. He retired as a

high school coach with 210 career victories. He finished his coaching career as the men's soccer assistant coach at Mount St. Mary's University from 2004-2008.




KENNETH R. PUTNAM, JR.



For more than 25 years, Kenneth Putnam has been a major contributor to the Frederick County soccer landscape. Putnam was a four-year varsity starter, three-time all-conference and two-time all-state honoree while graduating as one of the program's all-time leading scorers. He earned All-Maryland JuCo, All-Region XX and 1995 NCSAA JuCo All-American third-team honors while playing for Frederick Community College. He started his coaching career in 1997 at FCC and entered the high school coaching ranks in 2000. He was the head coach at Brunswick from 2005-2012, posting a 77-35-8 record with three state tournament appearances, including the 2012 Class 1A state title. He became Hood College's head coach in 2014 and is

the program's all-time winningest head coach.





JULIA ROBERTS



Julia Roberts is the most nationally decorated soccer player to hail from Frederick County. The Class of 2009 Urbana graduate played for the U.S. U16, U17 and U20 National Teams, helped the University of Virginia to four NCAA tournament appearances and played two years professionally for the Seattle Sounders and Washington Spirit. Roberts was a three-time high school all-state player, a two-time NSCAA High School All-American, a Parade All-American in 2009, and spent time as captain of the U.S. Under-17 National Team. She was part of the U.S. Under-17 team that won a silver medal in the 2008 FIFA Under-17 Women's World Cup. She scored a pair of goals leading Urbana to a state title in 2007 and had led her

club team, McLean Freedom, to a national title just a few months earlier. She was the nation's No. 4-rated prospect by ESPN in 2009.

SHELDON SHEALER



Sheldon Shealer is the most recognized youth soccer reporter in the U.S. The two-time soccer national feature writing award winner created and runs the FAB 50 national rankings. He has covered soccer for The Washington Post, FOX Sports, ESPN and USA Today, among other media outlets, and was tasked with selecting the Parade All-America teams for more than a decade. Shealer is the national high school soccer editor for TopDrawerSoccer, overseeing the national verbal commitment list and naming the TDS High School All-America Teams. In 2006, he created the Nike Premier 50 women's soccer event, for the nation's top prospects. Shealer helps in the selection of the High School All-America Game participants. Beyond youth soccer, he

has covered three World Cups and was co-editor of the Olympic Soccer daily newsletter for the 1996 Games.
